First Lady Robinson and I are excited about the move of the Holy Spirit; and, we appreciate and thank you for all that you do for Yesha Ministries.

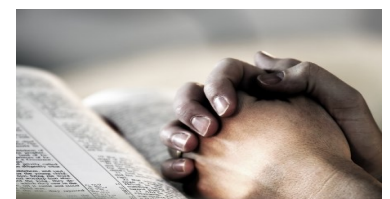

RUWACH UNITED FELLOWSHIP



In 1994, Bishop James Darrell Robinson was led by the Holy Spirit to form the RUWACH United Fellowship. RUWACH is Hebrew for breath or wind. Based on the scripture, Genesis, 1:1, "and the Spirit (RUWACH) of God moved over the face of the waters."

RUWACH is an organization of independent churches dependent on fellowship. The Bible says "if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship one with another." I John 1:7. Our goal is to build the work of God through genuine unity which can be accomplished through a shared commitment to win souls. This unity focuses on the work of Christ through the sharing of gifts that God has given to the individual churches affiliated with RUWACH.

Through crusades, conventions, fellowship services, professional Christian counseling, ministerial training, seminars and biblical training, just to name a few. We desire to strengthen and encourage growth in each ministry, especially new ministries. We have become increasingly, aware of the lack of support and aid new independent ministries receive, in fact, some even die. This is an atrocity and RUWACH is making a difference.

Churches united under RUWACH's umbrella will not be controlled or managed to build empires for men, but to build church stability and growth. It is our intent to be led by God's Spirit. RUWACH holds an interdenominational posture, which adheres to the Word of God.

RUWACH started with five churches from within the Philadelphia area and Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. While a few

of the founding churches have moved on, the organization continues to grow and now includes over fifteen churches both nationally and internationally.

Excitement is in the air as RUWACH prepares for its 19th Annual Conference from August 19th through 23rd!
